In 1910, when Hans Hoff and his son Theodore first arrived in McCall, Idaho, it was a primitive country, but they were amazed at the beauty of Payette Lake and the surrounding timbered mountains. For Hans, the tall trees and lofty mountains reminded him of the home he had left in Norway. Theodore had a youthful view of a future lumber

Trimco Millwork is a specialty wholesale distribution operation in the Intermountain region with locations in Boise, Idaho; Salt Lake City, Utah; and Denver, Colorado. Major product lines include mouldings, exterior doors, interior doors, and other specialty lines.


